## Alumni Spotlight: Chris Collins



This edition of the Alumni Spotlight highlights an alumnus with an impressive career in both the public and private sectors who has also been a very generous contributor to Rho Chapter's capital campaign. Chris Collins served four terms in the US Congress representing New York's 27<sup>th</sup> district. Chris also served Erie County as its County Executive bringing business oriented six sigma practices to the county government with tremendous results. Notably in the private sector, in 1998 Chris founded the infectious disease company ZeptoMetrix which played a key role in developing testing technology in the early days of the COVID-19 pandemic. Chris sold the company in late 2020.

Chris spent his teenage years in Hendersonville, NC and applied and was accepted into NC State's Mechanical Engineering program in 1968. He pledged Rho chapter in 1969 and spent several semesters as Bar Chair. Chris enjoyed running the bar

and has many fund memories with his brothers during that time. At the height of the protest movement against the war in Vietnam, this was a tumultuous time to be in college. Chris recalls that during his junior year, finals were canceled due to unrest on campus and in 1969 the active brothers created a betting pool for the first brother selected in the first ever draft lottery. Chris graduated NC State in 1972 and later was inducted into the North Carolina State University Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering Department Hall of Fame in 2015.

Chris is married to his wife Mary. He has three children, Carly, Caitlin, and Cameron and four grandchildren. He currently spends his time in Marco Island, FL where it is always 80 degrees, and he golfs six days a week.

#### Treasurer's Report

The amount in Alumni General Operations as of 12-31-2021 totals \$362,038.09. Our General Operations are comprised of restricted funds of \$347809.53 and unrestricted funds of \$14,228.53. The amount funds collected for pledges towards the purchase of the fraternity house is comprised of Capital Campaign Collections of \$284,084.79 and \$75,832.94 held with the Sigma PI Foundation for a grand total of \$359,917.73 at 12/31/21. Since the Capital Campaign with Pennington has concluded restricted fund reductions with be less in 2021 than previously in 2019 and 2020. Given the pace of Capital Campaign collections from 156 Alumni that have pledged, all restricted funds are expected to increase in the coming year.
