2009 Year in Review

Rho Chapter made significant strides in 2009! Our active brotherhood initiated 16 pledges during the year and finished up the year with 57 active brothers! This is the largest active brotherhood Rho has enjoyed in decades.

During Founders Day in February, the Rho Chapter of Sigma Pi Alumni Association was reactivated, elected a new Board of Directors, and has been meeting regularly since February addressing numerous issues of importance to the actives and alumni alike.

In March, the actives moved to their new home at 3414 Hillsborough Street, about a block away from Meredith College. The brothers have much more living space and have 11 brothers living in the house. The Alumni Board held numerous meetings at the House during the year and had several dinners with the actives during these meetings.

Our lot on Greek Way is still for sale. We had some interest in purchasing the lot last fall, but concerns over having the lot rezoned resulted in the purchase and sale contract being terminated and the offer being withdrawn. We are still in contact with the interested parties to try to work out an arrangement whereby the sale can go forward, as well as we continue to market the property. Meanwhile, the note on the land for \$50K plus interest will come due in August. Our goal is to sell the lot and pay off the note with the balance from the sale used to start a fund for long-term housing for the active brothers.
